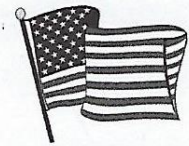

Economic Development Committee Meeting Tuesday, May 4, 2021

The meeting began at 7:35 PM with the Pledge of Allegiance. Mr. Accomando acknowledged all in attendance and stated that we have a very extensive agenda tonight. He then addressed all the representatives at this time and said when the establishment is called please state your name and position at that establishment and if business has been picking up with the ease of restrictions. The Committee then went on to address the Renewals. Mr. Accomando then called on each establishment separately and noted to the Committee that there were very little incidents to report and applications have improved greatly. Mr. Accomando told the establishments to be aware of what goes on outside of their establishment and to take notes of police activity due to the fact that the incident would be reported with their address regardless if it happened in their establishment. After a discussion between the establishment and the Committee members. The Chairman made a motion to accept the renewals and it was made by Mr. Popovic and seconded by Mr. Bieder. The vote was unanimous.

The Chair also noted that there were no incidents reported at this location. And acknowledged that the new owner has done a great job in turning around a once problematic location. The owner addressed all of

the Committee’s questions and was aware of all the concerns at that location noting that she lives in the area as well. At this time the Chairman made a motion to accept. It was made Mr. Smith and second by Mr. Popovic. The vote was unanimous.
