Meeting called to order at 7:03 p.m.

1. New Liquor License Application

- a. The renewal liquor license Application of El Rinconsito Latino, 500 Morris Park Ave. was tabled to follow-up on the owner's claim that his license did not, in fact, expire on 7/31/2016 as noted on the NYSLA website. Owner claims corporation name has been changed to Latino Sports Bar & Restaurant and that this is the name the new license was given to them under. 49th Precinct will visit establishment to verify that there is a current liquor license under the new corporate name.
- b. Extension of Hours

The committee considered the extension of hours request made by Hugh Hawthorne, owner of Ethics Bar & Lounge, Inc., 1246 E. Gun Hill Road. The committee heard from the 49th Precinct, the bar's owner and his son. Tony Signorile made a motion (seconded by Shradhanand Pirtam) to recommend that Community Board 11 allow the establishment to remain open until 4:00 a.m. on Tuesday, Thursday, Friday and Saturday and until 1:00 a.m. on Sunday Monday and Wednesday. Motion passed 5-1 with Dominick Schiano voting against the motion.
