Advantage Open Enrollment Period by Gabrielle Torres, Outreach and Enrollment Coordinator at Urban Health	 Health Plan spoke about the open enrollment for community residents who have Medicare Part A and B. Medicare Advantage (also known as "Part C") is an "all in one" alternative to Original Medicare. These "bundled" plans include Part A, Part B, and usually Part D (medication). They also may offer extra benefits Original Medicare doesn't cover. One person can have Medicaid and Medicare. (Duals) Although someone with Medicaid can enroll through the year, those who only have Medicare can enroll in a Medicare Advantage only once. This period is call Open Enrollment. This year, Open enrollment is between October 15, 2020 to December 7, 2020. Changes will be effective on January 2021. If you're in a Medicare Advantage Plan (with or without drug coverage), you can switch to another Medicare Advantage Plan (with or without drug coverage) You can drop your Medicare Advantage Plan and return to Original Medicare. You'll also be able to join a Medicare Prescription Drug Plan. Most common types of Medicare Advantage Plans:
