  - 1. Ceasar Delgado, Department of City Planning
    - a) They provided a slideshow and handout presenting the Zoning Amendment "City of Yes for Economic Opportunity" The presentation detailed 18 Points that were discussed in detail with committee and community members. These proposals focused on economic recovery, creating and expanding more vibrant commercial spaces and eliminating red tape for small businessesto name a few.     - b) A motion to provide a letter in favor of the proposed zoning amendment, with comments, was presented to the committee. The motion passed unanimously. The motion read as follows:
      - (1) The Housing, Land Use & Economic Development Committee of Bronx CB 7 is in favor of providing a letter of support to the Dept of City Planning for the proposed zoning amendment: "City of Yes for Economic Opportunity" with the following comments:
      - (2) *Item #5- Upper floor commercial* Must be business specific & in coordination with related agencies.



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- (3) Item #9 -Nightlife This needs to be in a commercial corridor, include soundproofing, regulate the size & in coordination with related agencies.
- (4) *Item #11- Home Occupations* The business needs to be duly licensed & in coordination with related agencies.
- G. Sandra Erickson raised the fact that there have been more than 100 fires in NYC caused by e-bikes. The group shared specific cases both in and out of CB7. Chair Arias shared that Councilmember Eric Dinowitz plans to hold a Town Hall in January 2024, in conjunction with FDNY, that will highlight and educate the public on potential fire hazards from all sources
