 - A) The Doe Fund of their project located at 3188 Villa Avenue given by:

 - B) This is a 68 Unit project that will provide studio (60) and 1 Bedroom apartments (8).
 - 1) The projected residents will be Seniors and individuals with Chronic illness
 - 2) The facility a 10 Story building will have 24 hour security, program staff & full time managers & social workers.
 - 3) This will be Permanent Housing and a dry facility with a maintenance staff and an emergency hot line.
 - 4) Residents will be chosen by a referral system and also have primary Doctors.
 - 5) Building will be ADA compliant.
 - 6) Funding will be through HPD with an AMI of 60%.

III) Motion(s)

- A) The Doe Fund will work with the appropriate agencies to prioritize a percentage of the 27 senior units for residents of Community Board #7.
 - 1) Motion was passed to send a letter of support with certain provisions.
 - (a) The process for applying for these apartments is advertised in a timely manner throughout the Community Board 7 neighborhood.
 - (b) Employment opportunities, as a result of this project, are offered to local residents.
- IV) An update was given on The Doe Fund project located at 3100 Webster Avenue; an 82 Unit 1 and 2 Bedroom facility is 80% finished and should open in May of 2018.
