## TRAFFIC & TRANSPORTATION COMMITTEE MINUTES

### Monday, June 22<sup>nd</sup>, 2009 @ 6:30 PM

- I) City presentation: Representatives from the firm of Weidlinger Associates made a presentation about proposed improvements on Mosholu Parkway. Copies of the plans were given to CB7. The Committee on the whole liked the plans.
  - A) The Committee felt the problem of flooding on the Parkway was not covered in a detailed manner.
  - B) The committee also suggested that the intersection of the Grand Concourse and East Mosholu Parkway South could be eliminated.
  - C) Issues such as pedestrian paths, crosswalk, lighting as well as improvements to the WW1 Monument need to be addressed.
  - D) The Chair and District Manager will write a letter to Mr. Anthony Nieves of Department of Design and Construction expressing CB7 concerns
- II) Follow-up status of Projects:
  - A) Bx28 Bus Stop-The Parks Department must check the condition of 2 trees on the site. If trees are dead, then they must be cut down before a shelter can be built. There is enough space with the removal of the trees for a shelter.
  - B) Gun Hill and Bainbridge Ave Project-CB7 has never received a letter stating what work was done at this area.
  - C) Amory Question-The Committee requests that East 195 Street between Aqueduct Ave and Jerome Ave be kept open for construction workers parking during work on the Amory. When the work is done, then have the street de-listed.
