TRAFFIC & TRANSPORTATION COMMITTEE MINUTES Thursday, September 15th, 2011 @ 6:30 PM

- I) Calendar for Traffic and Transportation Meetings: The Committee will meet the 2nd Thursday of every month at the CB7 Office 229-A East 204th Street. Meeting time 6:30 pm. May 2012 meeting will be on the 3rd Thursday of the month.
- II) The City Council is evaluating naming the Street Corner of East Mosholu Parkway North and Webster Ave in memory of Officer Eric Hernandez.
- III) The DOT Summer Walk Program was a big success. Even with the very warm weather, people turned out for the three Sunday. With each Sunday, more and more local merchant put up a table in front of their store. Hopefully, next year more local organization will be able to get involved.

IV) MTA issues raised:

- A) Does the 204 St. entrance/exit of the Bedford Park stop on the D subway line have a camera? Is it working and should it be replaced with a wider lens camera.
- B) Does the southern end entrance of the Mosholu Parkway stop on the #4 subway line have a camera?
- C) Could the after 10pm weekend schedule for the BX1 bus line be check? People are out later on weekends and the bus travels the whole length of the Bronx's.
- D) How often is the BX34 bus scheduled to run in an hour?
- E) The chair will ask MTA about these issues.
- V) Making Vila Ave, Gates Place and Knox's Place One-Way Streets was discussed.
- VI) Question asked if crossing time at 198th Street and Grand Course had been shortened. Matter will be looked at.
