

 - Flushing Avenue (between Wilson and Bushwick Ave.);
 - Bushwick Avenue (between Flushing Ave. and Moore St.);
 - Moore St, (between Bushwick Ave. & Manhattan Ave.);
 - Manhattan Ave. (between Moore St. & Montrose Ave.);
 - Montrose Ave. (between Lorimer St. & Graham Ave.).



This phase of construction will terminate at the intersection of Montrose Ave. & Manhattan Ave. (Presentation limited to 20 minutes).
