- Medicare Recipients must bring:
- Copy of Medicare Card and a Government-issued Photo ID (Drivers/Non Drivers license).
- Non-Medicare Recipients must:
- Obtain a Reduced-Fare Disability Application; to be completed by a certified physician and bring a Government-issued Photo ID (Drivers/Non Drivers license).
 - SSI (Supplemental Security Income) recipients, due to Serious Mental Illness must provide their Social Security Number for verification and bring a Government-issued Photo ID (Drivers/Non Drivers license).
