2. All shipments and deliveries of such equipment shall be accompanied by a certificate or label certifying that the equipment shipped or delivered are equivalent to those tested and acceptable for use, as provided for in Section 27-131 of the Building Code.
3. Approval of all electrical equipment, apparatus, materials and devices shall be obtained from the Bureau of Electrical Control before installation.
