**Description – These units are counter top conveyor bun toasters. Each uses one heating element within the rear conveyor for toasting the bun and a smaller element located within the front conveyor to maintain heat within the unit. The Crown and Heel of the buns are fed into separate slots at the top of the toaster. The buns are then toasted and dropped into a catch at the bottom. Unit comprises on-off switch and control switches, heating elements, limit thermostat, load timer and controls.**

**Recommendation - That the above electric commercial toasters, be accepted, under the following conditions:**

1. Units shall be installed in accordance with manufacturer's instructions and New York City Electrical Code requirements.

2. Adequate supply of fresh air shall be provided into room or space enclosing equipment for ventilation requirements.
3. Satisfactory room exhaust system shall be furnished.
4. The installation shall not interfere with accessibility for operation and servicing.
5. All shipments and deliveries of such equipment shall be provided with a metal tag, suitably placed, certifying that the equipment shipped or delivered is equivalent to that tested and accepted for use, as provided for in Section 27-131 of the Building Code.
6. Approval of electrical equipment, apparatus, materials and devices shall be obtained from the Bureau of Electrical Control before installation.
