Description: Gas-fired air furnaces designed for indoor installation. Unit is comprised of induced draft (power exhaust), aluminized steel main burner, heat exchanger assembly, pressure switch, an intermittent-ignition system comprising of a pilot burner and igniter (electrode), flame sensor, ignition module and combination gas pressure regulator. Units, with model numbers and input heating ratings, are listed below:

Terms and Conditions: That the above-described high-efficiency gas furnaces are accepted under the following conditions:

- 1. Units shall be installed indoors only.
- 2. Units shall use natural gas only.
- 3. Minimum installation clearances from combustible construction shall be in accordance with RS 14-15 of the New York City Building Code.
- 4. If utilized for residence heating, circulatory air system shall have (a) one register or grille without closable shutters and the duct leading thereto shall be without a damper or, (b) dampers and shutters within the system shall be constructed or controlled so as to prevent closure beyond 80 percent of the gross duct area at all times.
- 5. Approval shall be obtained from the Department of Environmental Protection, Bureau of Air Resources, to show compliance with their rules and regulations for fuel/gas-burning equipment.
- 6. No automatic flue damper device shall be installed in conjunction with these units.
- 7. If furnace is installation ion combination with a cooling system, then the cooling system shall be MEA accepted.
- 8. Approval of electrical equipment, apparatus, materials and devices shall be obtained from the Department's Electrical Advisory Control Board before installation.
- 9. Units shall be used in compliance with the Energy Conservation Construction Code of New York State.
- 10. All shipments and deliveries of such equipment shall be provided with a metal tag, suitably placed, certifying that the equipment shipped or delivered is equivalent to that tested and accepted for use, as provided for in Section 27-131 of the New York City Building Code.
