Terms and Conditions: The above-described gas-fired vented appliances are accepted for decorative heating under the following conditions:

- 2. Units are for indoor installation only with combustible air and required ventilation air provided.
- 3. Venting of the equipment is subject to Section 27-879 of the New York City Building Code.
- 4. Approval of all electrical equipment, apparatus, materials and devices shall be obtained from the Department's Electrical Advisory Board before installation.
- 5. Units shall be used in compliance with the Energy Conservation Construction Code of New York State.
- All shipments and deliveries of such equipment shall be provided with a metal tag, suitably placed, certifying that the equipment shipped or delivered is equivalent to that tested and accepted for use, as provided in Section 27-131 of the New York City Building Code.
