

# Submit 3D Site Safety Plans Electronically

The Department of Buildings is now electronically accepting three-dimensional site safety plans. Using Building Information Modeling (BIM) software, designers can create sophisticated, modernized site safety plans that will enhance construction safety, promote collaboration between property owners, architects, engineers and the Department – and accelerate the approval process.

Filings for new buildings and alteration type-2 façade renovations require site safety plans, and these types of projects are eligible to submit three-dimensional site safety plans.



This service upgrade enables applicants to upload amendments – allowing inspectors to access the most up-to-date information while they're in the field using portable electronic devices.

Submit BIM site safety plans in three steps:

1. **Notification:** Email [BIM@buildings.nyc.gov](mailto:BIM@buildings.nyc.gov) to notify the Department that you'll submit BIM documents.
2. **Registration:** Register to use the [online document management program](#).
3. **Submission:** Upload and submit site safety plans through the [online document management program](#).
