Description – CCAF Liquid Chiller. Condenserless indoor unit designed to chill water for circulation in commercial air conditioning or process cooling system. Uses R-22 Refrigerant. Contains one ASME pressure vessel with MAWP = 300 psi.

Recommendation - That the above described liquid chiller be accepted for indoor installation only, when using refrigerant R-22, under the following conditions:

1. All equipment shall be furnished with a permanently affixed metal tag, stating that if installed in New York City within 100 feet of any dwelling unit window, there shall be compliance with all provisions of Section 27-770, as to maximum sound levels permitted for exterior mechanical equipment.
2. All shipments and deliveries of such equipment shall be provided with a metal tag, suitably placed, certifying that the equipment shipped or delivered is equivalent to that tested and acceptable for use, as provided for in Section 27-131 of the Building Code.
3. Approval of all electrical equipment, apparatus, materials and devices shall be obtained from the Bureau of Electrical Control before installation.
