Who is NYPA?


- Largest state-owned public power organization in the U.S.
- Owns and operates 18 power plants throughout New York State. Supplying one-fifth of New York's State's Electricity.
- Operates more than 1,400 circuit-miles of the State's transmission system.
- Supplies Electricity to Governmental, Municipal and co-operative electric systems in Upstate NY and LI.
- Supplies Electricity in South East New York to State, NYC and Westchester Governmental Customers.
- Not-for-Profit Public Benefit Corporation
- Uses no tax revenues or state credit.
- One of New York State's valuable partners in Economic Development.

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NYPA and NYC Cogeneration

- NYPA's Support of Cogeneration
- Completed Projects:
 - Fuel Cells - 2.4 MW (all interconnected, except
– NYPD Fuel Cell in Central Park. Stand alone)
 - Photovoltaic - 430 KW (interconnected)
- Current projects:
 - Fuel Cells- 1.4 MW
 - Rikers Island 15 MW Gas Turbine Plant
 - 100 MW Statewide Solar Initiative.



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Standby Rates

Service Tariff 100

- Rate Schedule for NYPA's NYC Governmental Customers
- Rider A for Back Up and Maintenance Power
- Rate Schedule
 - Energy: On-Peak: 18.1 cents/kwh (7AM-7PM)
 - Off- Peak: 3.287 cents/kwh (all other times)
 - Demand Charge: \$15.93/KW-mo (All hours, all days)
- Present Rates will be updated in the near future.



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NYPA Incentives

- NYPA offers no Incentives because we do not participate in the SBC Fund. This Fund is supported by NY State's six investor owned Utilities, through the collection of a surcharge on the customers bill for funding energy efficiency projects. Program is administered by NYSERDA. Rider A for Back Up and Maintenance Power
- NYPA Offers low cost financing and Energy Efficiency Programs to our customers for the implementation of Energy Efficiency projects.
