

SUBJECT: Review of building notice applications for cranes with booms over 250 feet and for derricks (Form 21c)-Modifies Directive 14/75.

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Directive 14/75 is hereby modified to require review of building notice applications for cranes with booms, including any extensions, over 250 feet, and also for derricks. The building notice application for an on-site inspection for such machines shall be referred to the Crane and Derrick Division. Upon approval of the use of the crane or derrick by the Crane and Derrick Division, further examination of the calculations for the founding of the crane or derrick will not be necessary unless specifically requested by the applicant.

In the matter of field inspection of the founding of the crane or derrick in order to check compliance with the architects or engineers plans, section 5 of Directive #14/75 will apply.
