

SUBJECT:

RE-ENTRY FROM FIRE TOWERS  
LOCAL LAW #5/1973

The requirement that doors shall be openable from the stair side at intervals of four stories or less under C26-604.4(i)(1)b3 shall not apply to fire towers which are in full compliance with the construction and arrangement requirements of (6.5.2) of Sec. C26-294.0 of the "Old Code"; provided that no standpipe riser is located within or in close proximity to the fire tower stairway.
