
TO: Borough Superintendents  
FROM: Thomas V. Burke, Director of Operations  
SUBJECT: Statements A and B (E Form 17, B Form 18)

The two forms noted above require that the registered architect or licensed professional engineer state that he is duly authorized by the owner, "who is the owner in fee of all that certain lot, piece or parcel of land" \_ \_ \_ to make application for the approval of such detailed statements of specifications and plans, etc.

The architect or engineer who files Statement A or Statement B will be permitted to add the words "to the applicant's best knowledge and belief" following the word "who" and preceding the words "is the owner in fee of all that certain lot, piece or parcel of land" etc. The paragraph would thus read as follows, "Applicant further states that he is duly authorized by \_\_\_\_\_ who, to the applicant's  
Name of Owner  
best knowledge and belief, is the owner in fee of all that certain lot, piece or parcel of land, shown on the diagram" \_ \_ \_ etc.

This memorandum shall be effective immediately.
