

# EXPERIENCE IS NOT ENOUGH

## Housekeeping Safety

- Storage areas should be specifically designated and clearly defined.
- Storage areas should not encroach into working areas.
- Storage areas should adequately protect against dislodgement by wind or accidental impact.
- Materials or debris should not be packed above the top of storage containers.
- Avoid storage near publicly accessible areas.

# EXPERIENCE IS NOT ENOUGH

Maintaining an orderly, clean, and efficient job site is **everyone's responsibility.**

Working areas should be kept safe and obstruction free.

- Keep access and egress pathways clear.
- Clear walking and working surfaces of tripping hazards.
- Remove obstructions from stairways, passageways, and gangways.
- Develop a proper housekeeping program.

Excessive debris and trash not placed in designated bins or areas

Stairways, passageways, and gangways not free of material, supplies, and obstructions

Inadequate access and egress pathways
