Follow-up #1: [Local Law 59 of 2019](#) - Free Construction Project Status Updates Now Available by Email for DOB NOW: *Build Jobs*

Sign-up to receive free email notifications on the status of a construction project filed with the Department of Buildings in the Buildings Information System (BIS) and in DOB NOW: *Build* will begin February 19, 2020.

Email Notification Sign-up

To sign-up to receive email notifications, visit the Department's website and enter your email address and the Job Number(s) of the construction project(s) for which you want to receive status updates. The Department will send you weekly emails showing the status of each Job Number entered.

Finding Your Construction Project Job Number in BIS

Go to **Buildings Information System (BIS)** on the Department's website, enter the address of the building and click *Jobs/Filings* on the *Property Profile Overview*. The Job Number and the Job Status for each of the projects at that building will be displayed.

Finding Your Construction Project Job Number in DOB NOW

Go to [DOB NOW](#) on the Department's website, enter the address of the building, and click on **BUILD: Job Filings**. The Job Number for each of the projects at that building will be displayed.
