### **Plumbing, Fire Suppression & Electrical License Boards: Accepting Applications for Members**

The Department is seeking plumbing and electrical experts to serve on the 2017 Master Plumbers & Master Fire Suppression Piping Contractors License Board and the 2017 Master and Special Electrician License Boards. The application deadline to be considered for participation is February 7, 2017.

#### Submission Information & Guidelines

- Applicants **must** submit a current résumé and checklist. Please keep in mind, these are volunteer positions.
- If an applicant wishes to represent an organization, a nomination letter from an officer of the organization **must** be submitted.
- Email applications to [PlumbingBdandComm@buildings.nyc.gov](mailto:PlumbingBdandComm@buildings.nyc.gov). All application submissions **must** include the applicant's résumé and checklist.

*NOTE: Other New York City agencies may review submissions.*

#### REQUIREMENTS: Becoming a Plumbing & Fire Suppression License Board Member

The **Plumbing & Fire Suppression License Board** is comprised of licensees from the plumbing, sprinkler and fire suppression industries, in addition to representatives from the real estate, architectural and engineering communities. Together, the Board reviews qualifications of license applicants in compliance with the 2014 NYC Administrative Code. Potential Board members **must** be able to meet approximately once a month and have any one of the required backgrounds:

- Licensed Master Plumbers actively engaged in the trade – Association of Contracting Plumbers of City of New York Inc. or Master Plumber's Council of the City of New York Inc.
- Licensed Master Plumber with Fire Suppression License (Class A or B) – Association of Contracting Plumbers of the City of New York Inc.
- Licensed Master Fire Suppression Piping Contractors (Class A) – Mechanical Contractors Association of New York Inc.
- Registered Journeyman Plumbers – United Association of Plumbers, Local 1
- Registered Journeyman Fire Suppression Piping Installers – United Association of Steamfitters' Local Union 638

- NYS Licensed Professional Engineers with five years of experience designing plumbing systems
- NYS Licensed Professional Engineers with full membership in the Society of Fire Protection Engineers
- NYS Registered Architects
- Real estate Owners/managers (or their representatives)

**REQUIREMENTS: Becoming a Master and Special Electrician License Board Member**

Electrical experts with a background in electrical work have opportunities to serve on the Electrician's License Board. The **Master and Special Electrician License Board** reviews license applications for compliance with the NYC 2011 Electrical Code Administrative provisions. Potential Board members should expect to meet twice a month and **must** have one of the following backgrounds:

- Licensed Master Electrician actively engaged in the trade
- Electrical Journeyman
- Electrician employed by a utility company
- Licensed Professional Engineer (P.E.) or Registered Architect (R.A) – each with a minimum of five years of experience
- Real Estate Owner or manager (or a representative)
