# **Elevator Applications: Post-Hurricane Repairs**

All repair or replacement work to elevators damaged by Hurricane Sandy must be filed with the Department and comply with the below guidelines.

## **Elevator Building Notice (EBN) Required**

To remove, dismantle, alter, repair or replace equipment for an existing device, the Department requires an EBN. To do this, submit an <u>Elevator Application</u> (ELV1 form). For assistance, review the <u>Elevator Application instructions</u>.

### **Filing Minor Alterations**

<u>Operations Policy and Procedure Notice 26/90</u> outlines self-certification requirements for contractors to sign-off on minor alterations to elevators. This is acceptable for minor work that does not require a test to be performed in the presence of a Department of Buildings inspector.

### **Required Work Standards**

All emergency work, minor alterations and ordinary repairs must be performed according to the requirements outlined in 1 RCNY §28-105 .4.1 and §28-105.4.2, as well as the American Society of Mechanical Engineers (ASME) A17.1/2003, as modified by Appendix K of the NYC Building Code.
