Reynaldo Cabrera is a dedicated public servant with over 15 years of experience in law enforcement, criminal investigations, fraud prevention, and prosecution. He is currently the Risk Management Officer for the New York City Department of Buildings (DOB) responsible for the Agency's risk mitigation in DOB processes, and in the identification of potential vulnerabilities.

As head of the recently created Office of Risk Management, Mr. Cabrera works with DOB's Enforcement Bureau and the Legal & Regulatory Affairs Unit using business intelligence and analytical tools to proactively identify and pursue punishment of corrupt behavior; identify buildings that pose a threat to public safety; and actively penalize individuals in conjunction with the New York City Department of Investigation.

Before joining DOB, Mr. Cabrera served as a New York County Assistant District Attorney. In this role he prosecuted a range of cases including quality-of-life offenses, financial crimes, public corruption and violent crimes. In addition, as a founding member of the Crime Strategies Unit, Mr. Cabrera worked with law enforcement partners and community stakeholders to identify groups and individuals who were disproportionately responsible for the commission of crime in the community.

Assigned to coordinate law enforcement strategies for parts of Northern Manhattan and Transit, Mr. Cabrera investigated and developed the intelligence that ultimately led to the indictment of violent gang members and other individuals. He also helped develop and identify technological solutions to assist in managing big-data to help identify and detect patterns of criminality among disparate data sources. In addition to his duties as a prosecutor, Mr. Cabrera was a member of the Office's Permanent Hiring Board and the Diversity Committee.

Mr. Cabrera earned his Juris Doctorate from The Catholic University of America in Washington, DC, and his Bachelor of Arts degree from the College of the Holy Cross in Worcester, MA. A Manhattan resident, Mr. Cabrera enjoys spending quality time with his wife Susan and their two children.
