14TH TO 47TH STREETS, SIXTH AVENUE TO THE HUDSON RIVER


The *West Side Safety Team* is dedicated to large-scale, current and upcoming construction projects on Manhattan's West Side. Coordinating with the Buildings Enforcement Safety Team and Department specialty units, *West Side Safety Team* inspectors will focus on cranes and derricks, excavations, scaffolds and construction hoists at New Building, major alterations and demolition projects. With projects in the Hudson Yards area now set to create more than 11 million square feet of space – and 13 million more square feet in construction expected in the coming years – this team will facilitate the safe and compliant development at these sites.

Services + Oversight

- Remain current on all Job Schedules;
- Participate in Job Management meetings;
- Oversee all enforcement actions, including Stop Work Orders; and
- Coordinate oversight: Cranes & Derricks, Excavation, Buildings Enforcement Safety Team (BEST), Scaffold Safety Team (SST) and Construction Hoists.
