Occupy Wall Street Summary**

This information is subject to change as complaint information is updated and investigations are pursued.

Since the beginning of the Occupy Wall Street demonstrations, the CCRB has received 37 complaints falling under our traditional FADO jurisdiction (Force, Abuse of Authority, Discourtesy and Offensive Language). Other cases, 27, have been determined to fall outside our jurisdiction. These numbers are subject to change as we continue to investigate these matters and complaints are being filed stemming from present Occupy Wall street events. We already reported that we have received a significant number of contacts – an approximate 850 contacts – from people who saw video of events on television and the internet. We monitor all of these types of contacts.

Of the 37 complaints, in 19 cases neither arrests were made nor were summonses given. In 14 cases, arrests were made for either disorderly conduct or a violation or crime. In one instance, summonses were given. In three instances, the information is not available.

At present, although the number is subject to change, the number of identified complainants/ victims is 78. The number of current subject officers is 41.

In terms of allegations being investigated, 29 of the 44 allegations are improper use of force. Generic complaints of physical force are the most common. There are other force allegations. They are the following: nightstick, the improper use of a vehicle, blunt instruments as club, chokehold, handcuffs too tight, use of animal and other forms of force. In addition, there is an offensive language allegation and the other 12 allegations are abuse of authority.

“This is a situation that we take seriously and continue to monitor,” said Board Chair Daniel D. Chu.
