The role of the Public Advocate is to be a watchdog and check on the Mayor, but the office doesn't have a guaranteed budget to prevent cuts.

Borough Presidents

Borough presidents are responsible for coordinating agency services in their boroughs; and also play a role in the budget and land use processes. Their budgets are not protected from cuts.

Proposal:

Set minimum budgets for the Public Advocate and Borough Presidents.
