RE: Pedicab Insurance is Required for the Full License Term

Dear Mr. [REDACTED]

I am writing in reply to your inquiry whether you may cancel your insurance policy for 15 registered pedicabs, while they are kept in storage, and reinsure them when you take them out of storage. The short answer is no.

Pursuant to Section 20-250 (b) (3) of the New York City Administrative Code ("the Code"), "in order to obtain ... a pedicab business license, a pedicab owner must provide ... proof that there is in force for the full license term a policy of public liability and property damage insurance ... for each pedicab ..." Pursuant to Section 20-253(e), if you cancel or allow your pedicab insurance to lapse during the license term, your pedicab license "shall become void."
