



Does Your Consumer Affairs License Expire February through June 2020?

Read This Important Update.

A COVID-19 Relief Package, signed into law by Mayor Bill de Blasio, extends the license expiration dates and renewal application deadlines covered by Emergency Executive Orders (EEO) 107 and 110. In general, the extension applies to licenses with expiration dates on or after March 12, 2020 when the Mayor first declared a state of emergency. NEW Renewal Application Deadlines are calculated from when EEO 110 expires.

IMPORTANT:

- Employment Agency and Scrap Metal Processor licenses are *not* covered by EEO; these license expiration dates are set by State law.
- If your license is expired—that is, the expiration date is *not* extended—you may not operate until you get your renewed license.
- Monitor nyc.gov or nyc.gov/dca for updates regarding when EEO 110 expires.
