

IDENTITY THEFT

In 2014, the Federal Trade Commission's Identity Theft Clearinghouse received **332,646** complaints, making ID Theft the number one reported crime for the 15th year in a row. New York State ranked 17th in the nation for ID Theft complaints with **15,959** complaints—**81** for every **100,000** residents. New York City residents accounted for **55%** of all complaints in the state (**8,704**).

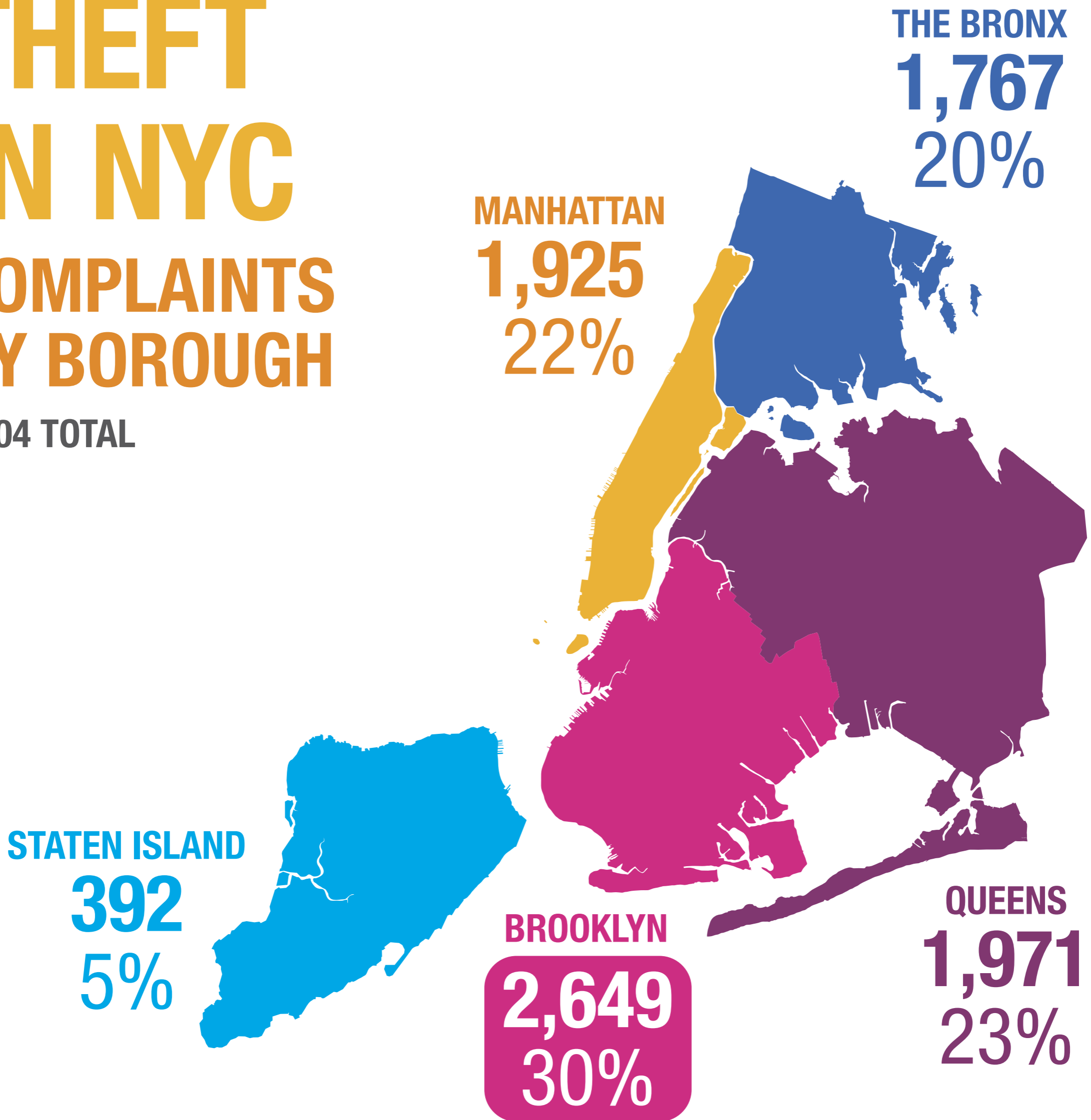

COMPLAINTS BY BOROUGH

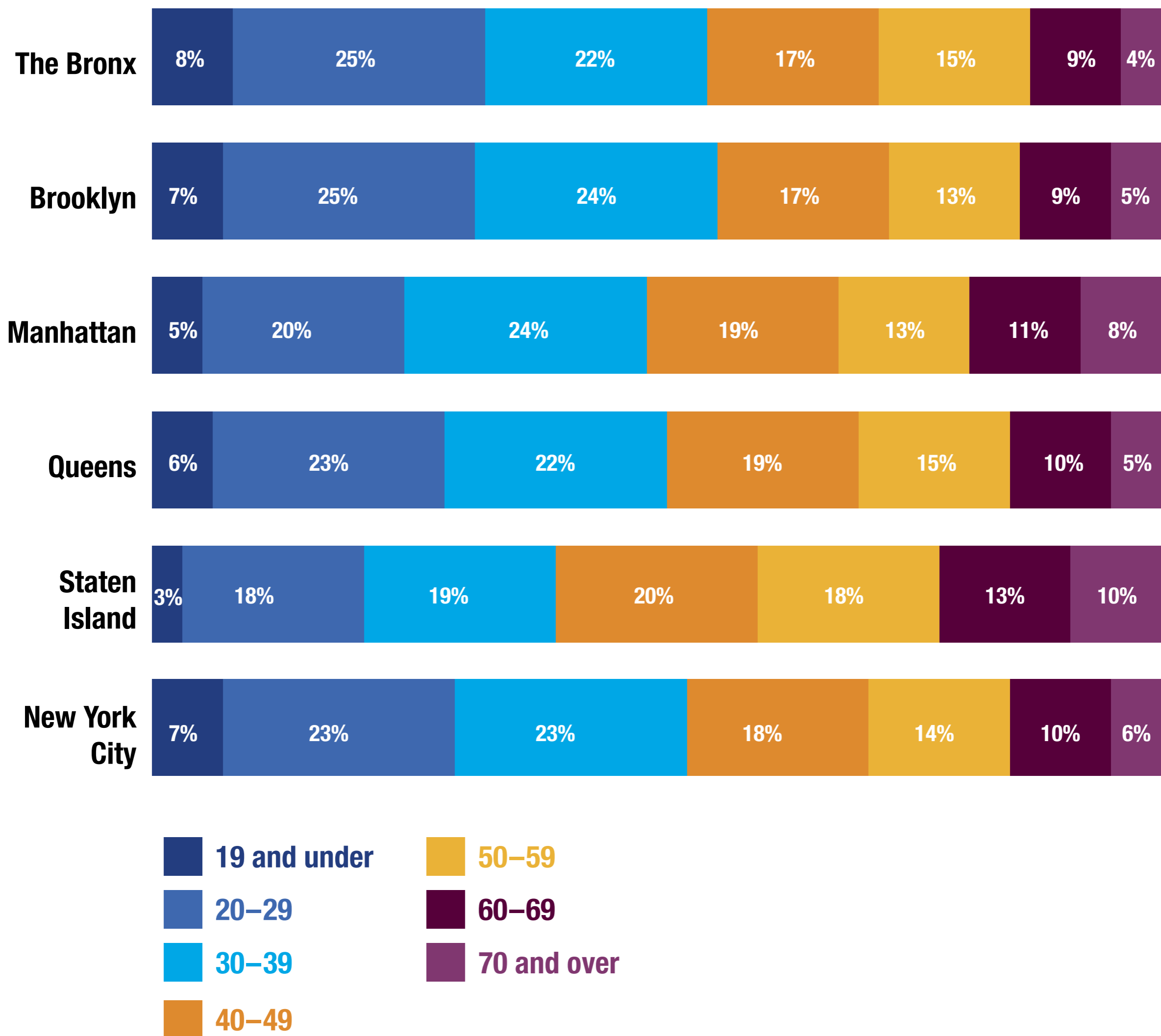

AGE OF COMPLAINANTS

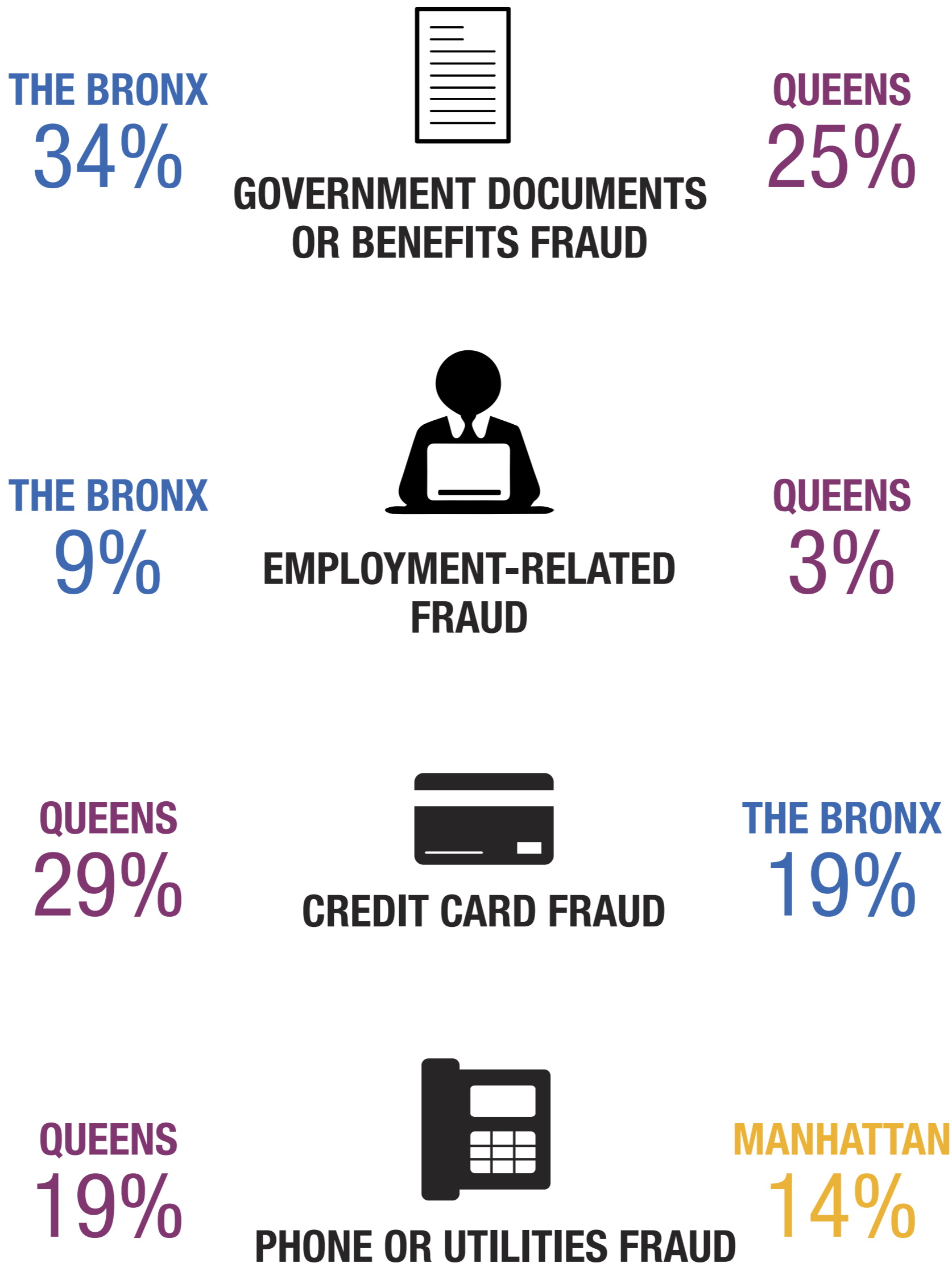
Nearly half, **46%**, were between the ages of **20–39**. Fewer than **15%** were under the age of **19** and over the age of **70**.

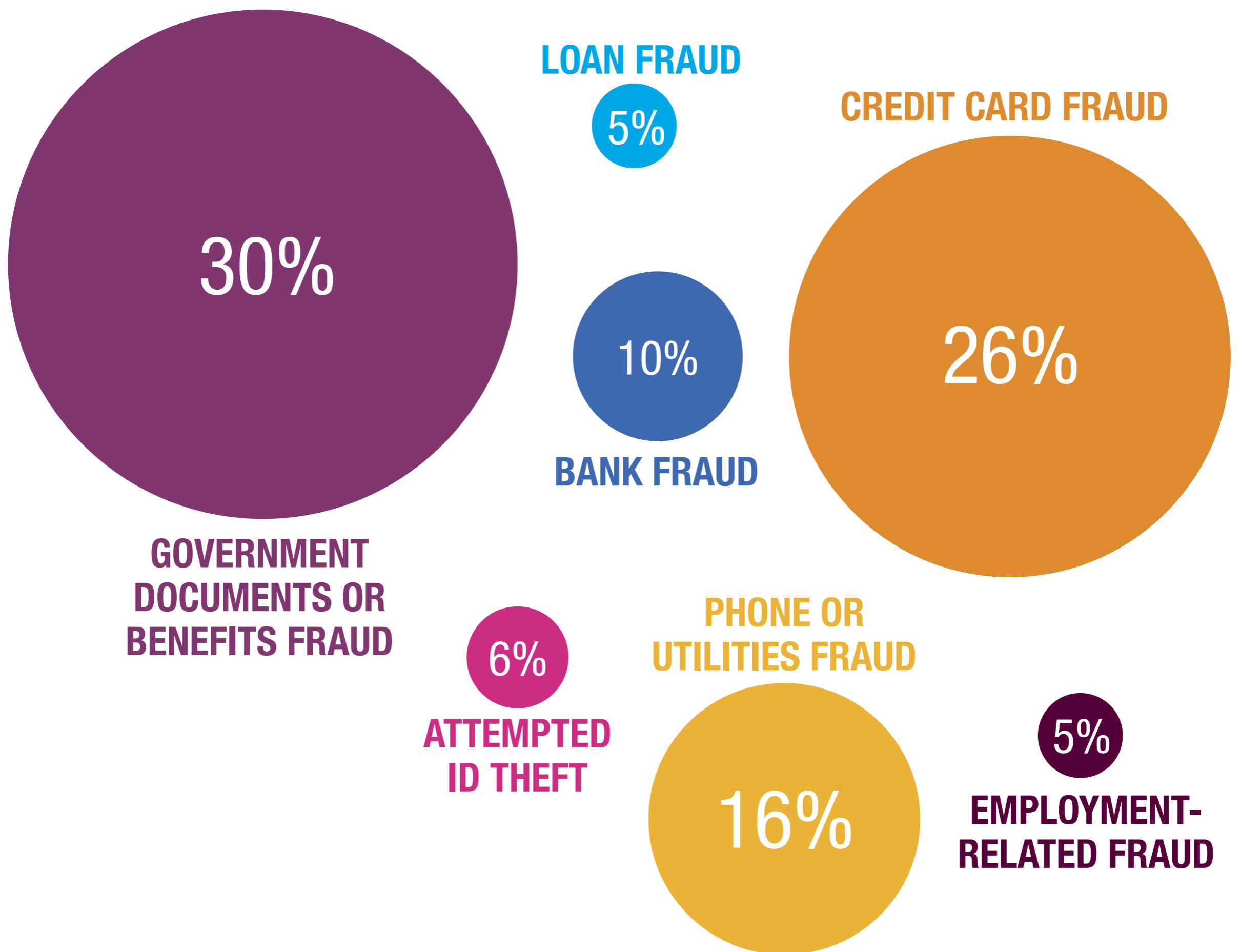
BOROUGH DIFFERENCES
