Under the Amended Project, SBRHDFC proposes to sell the Project Area to 161 Columbia Street Associates LLC, which will then develop a four-unit condominium housing project on the Project Area.

SBRHDFC and its parent organization, Carroll Gardens Association, Inc. ("CGA") propose the sale of the Project Area to generate funds to stabilize SBRHDFC's and CGA's affordable housing stock, including the affordable units developed under the Original Project, and the potential development of new affordable housing units. The proceeds from the sale of the Project Area will support the maintenance and operation of approximately 150 existing affordable housing units owned by CGA. The sale proceeds will ensure permanent affordability of these units that will be defined and memorialized in a regulatory agreement. The proceeds will also fund pre-development and planning costs associated with the development of approximately 75 new affordable housing units in Brooklyn's Red Hook neighborhood that will be built by CGA under storm-resiliency guidelines.
