WHAT THE JOB INVOLVES:

Motor Vehicle Supervisors (NYC H+H), under general supervision, supervise automotive servicing operations of a departmental garage/fleet, and/or are responsible for the dispatching of the personnel, motor vehicles and equipment assigned to a large garage/fleet. They schedule subordinate personnel to perform servicing, minor repairing and storage of automotive vehicles; inspect garage/fleet activities and facilities to ensure compliance with established standards and practices; investigate complaints on automotive servicing and operations; receive reports on the condition of motor vehicles and equipment repaired or needing repairs; direct the performance of minor repairs and refer major repairs to appropriate repair sections; review the utilization of motor vehicles and equipment by the different divisions of a department to determine efficient schedules for storage and servicing, and economical employment of facilities and garage/fleet personnel; prepare and enforce routines of periodic oiling, lubrication, and washing of vehicles, their tire servicing and the dispensing of gasoline as authorized for vehicular uses; deal with vendors to obtain servicing, repairs, equipment, and materials; initiate requisitions for needed supplies and automotive servicing equipment; supervise the maintenance of the garage/fleet and adjacent servicing premises in a clean and safe condition, with attention to the provision and operating condition of required fire safeguards; select and dispatch suitable motor equipment to various jobs; prepare trip instructions and designate the routes to be followed; investigate accidents in which assigned vehicles have been involved; prepare and review accident reports; keep attendance records, and keep records on the daily consumption of gasoline and oil and on the departure and arrival of motor vehicles; check condition of incoming and outgoing motor vehicles; instruct employees in the operation of specialized motor equipment, such as wreckers and heavy trucks; drive motor vehicles; may do aut

Special Working Conditions:

Motor Vehicle Supervisors (NYC H+H) may be required to work various shifts including nights, Saturdays, Sundays, and holidays.

Some of the physical activities performed by Motor Vehicle Supervisors (NYC H+H) and environmental conditions experienced are: working on or walking on wet concrete surfaces; working outdoors; working in areas where there may be fumes and odors of fuel and lubricants; lifting heavy objects; being alert, using vision and hearing to avoid injury from moving engine parts; reading fine print; and communicating orally in a noisy working environment.

(This is a brief description of what you might do in this position and does not include all the duties of this position.)

THE SALARY:

The current minimum salary is \$55,088 per annum. This rate is subject to change. There are two assignment levels within this class of positions. Promotions will be made to Assignment Level I. After promotion, employees may be assigned to the higher assignment level at the discretion of the agency.

ELIGIBILITY TO TAKE EXAMINATION:

This examination is open to each employee of NYC Health + Hospitals who on the last day of the application period:

(1) holds a permanent (not provisional) competitive appointment or appears on a

Preferred List (see Note, below) for the title of Motor Vehicle Operator (NYC H+H); and

(2) is not otherwise ineligible.

(Note: A "Preferred List" is a civil service list which is only for certain former permanent employees of the eligible title who have rehiring rights.)

READ CAREFULLY AND SAVE FOR FUTURE REFERENCE

This examination is also open to employees who were appointed to an eligible title pursuant to Regulation 4 of NYC Health + Hospitals' Personnel Rules and Regulations and who meet all other eligibility requirements.

If you do not know if you are eligible, check with your facility's Human Resources Department. You may be given the test before we verify your eligibility. You are responsible for determining whether or not you meet the eligibility requirements for this examination prior to submitting your application. If it is determined that you are not eligible to participate in this examination, your application fee will not be refunded and you will not receive a score.

ELIGIBILITY TO BE PROMOTED:

In order to be eligible for promotion, you must have completed your probationary period in the eligible title as indicated in the above "Eligibility To Take Examination" section, and you must be permanently employed in the eligible title or your name must appear on a Preferred List for the eligible title at the time of promotion.

REQUIREMENT(S) TO BE PROMOTED:

Driver License Requirement: You must have a motor vehicle driver license valid in the State of New York at the time of promotion. If you have moving violations, license suspension(s) or an accident record, you may be disqualified. This license must be maintained for the duration of your employment.

HOW TO APPLY:

If you believe you are eligible to take this examination, apply using the Online Application System (OASys) at *www.nyc.gov/examsforjobs*. Follow the onscreen application instructions for electronically submitting your application, payment, and completing any required information. A unique and valid email address is required to apply online. Several internet service providers, including but not limited to Google, Yahoo!, AOL, Outlook.com, and Mail.com offer free email addresses. All new OASys accounts require verification before a candidate can apply to ensure the accuracy of candidate information. Verification is instantaneous for most accounts and you will receive a confirmation email with instructions to activate your account. For any account creation issues, you will receive onscreen prompts to contact DCAS. This review may require up to two (2) business days to be reviewed and resolved. Please keep this information and the application period deadline in mind when creating your account.

The following methods of payment are acceptable: major credit card, bank card associated with a bank account, or a prepaid debit card with a credit card logo which you may purchase online or at various retail outlets. If you are receiving or participating in certain forms of public assistance/benefits/programs, or are a veteran, you may qualify to have the application fee waived. Effective January 2020, the Online Application System is no longer supported on Windows 7 or earlier versions of Windows operating systems.

You may come to the DCAS Computer-based Testing & Application Centers to apply for this examination online. However, you must schedule a customer service appointment prior to your visit. Due to the COVID-19 pandemic, DCAS no longer permits walk-ins at DCAS sites.

THE TEST:

You will be given an Education and Experience Exam. Your score on this test will be used to determine your place on an eligible list. On the Education and Experience Exam you will receive a score of 70 points for meeting the eligibility requirements listed above. After these requirements are met, you will receive additional credit up to a maximum of 100 points on the following basis:

During the Education and Experience Exam (EEE), you may answer questions about your experience. If your experience was on a part-time basis working less than 35 hours per week, you will need to convert your part-time experience to full-time experience using the formula below. Once you have determined your full-time experience equivalent, use this amount to answer questions about your experience.

12 points

15 points

(number of hours worked per week/35) x (number of months worked)

For example, if you worked at a job for 21 hours per week for 12 months, you would make the following calculation: $21/35 \times 12 = 7.2$ months.

You must clearly specify in detail all of your relevant education and experience on your Education and Experience Exam and submit it by the end of the Application Period. You will not receive credit for experience which you obtain after the end of the Application Period (February 27, 2024).

You have until midnight Eastern time on the last day of the Application Period (February 27, 2024) to clearly specify in detail all of your relevant education and experience and Final Submit your Education and Experience Exam in the Online Application System (OASys). Once you Final Submit your Education and Experience Exam in OASys, you will not be permitted to submit new or additional information online.

If you do not Final Submit your Education and Experience Exam in OASys by midnight Eastern time on the last day of the Application Period (February 27, 2024), your examination will be considered incomplete, you will not receive a score, you will not be invited to subsequent portions of this events of the application of this examination (if applicable), and your application fee will not be refunded.

Experience must be obtained by the last day of the Application Period (February 27, 2023).

THE TEST RESULTS:

If you pass the Education and Experience Exam and are marked eligible, your name will be placed in final score order on an NYC Health + Hospitals eligible list, you will be given a list number, and you will be notified by email of your test results. The eligible list determines the order by which candidates will be considered for promotion. If you meet all requirements and conditions, you will be considered for promotion if your name is reached on the eligible list.

If you believe that your test part was rated incorrectly, you may submit an appeal of your score to DCAS, Committee on Manifest Errors, through the Online Application System (OASys). Your appeal must give specific reasons why your score should be higher. Your appeal may result in a higher or lower rating.

access the appeal portal of OASys, please log into your OASys account at www.nyc.gov/examsforjobs and use the following steps:

- 1. Navigate to the Dashboard for the Appeals tab.
- 2. Click the NEW APPEAL button to create and submit your appeal.
- 3. Select the exam from the Exam drop-down list, and
- 4. Select the exam part from the Exam Part drop-down list.
- 5. Select the reason for your appeal from the Appeal Reason drop-down list (if applicable).
- 6. Enter the details of your appeal by providing specific reasons why your score should be higher.

ADDITIONAL INFORMATION:

Selective Certification for Commercial Driver License (CDA): If you have a Class A, B or C Commercial Driver License that is valid in the State of New York with passenger and air brakes endorsement, you may be considered for promotion to positions requiring this license through a process called Selective Certification. If you qualify for Selective Certification, you may be given preferred consideration for positions requiring this license. If you wish to apply for this Selective Certification, follow the onscreen instructions when completing your Education and Experience Exam to indicate your interest in such Selective Certification and Final Submit it in the Online Application SYstem (OASys). Your license will be checked by the NYC H+H at the time of promotion. This license must be maintained for the duration of the employment.

Alcohol and Drug Screening Requirement (For Commercial Driver License Selective Certification Only): You must pass an alcohol and drug screening in order to be promoted.

The above Selective Certification requirement may be met at anytime during the duration of the list. If you meet this requirement at some future date, please submit a request by email to: *LMACustomerService@dcas.nyc.gov*, or by mail to: DCAS Bureau of Examinations - Exam Development Group, 1 Centre Street, 14th Floor, NY 10007. Please include the examination title and number, your full name, OASys Profile ID number, and the selective certification you are requesting in your correspondence.

List Termination: The eligible list resulting from this examination will be terminated one year from the date it is established, unless extended by NYC Health + Hospitals.

This examination is for positions with NYC Health + Hospitals only and not for City agencies. If you would like to apply for the promotion examination for Motor Vehicle Supervisor with City Agencies, you must submit a separate application and fee for Exam No. 4565 from February 7, 2024 through February 27, 2024.

Application Receipt: You will be emailed a receipt immediately after you have applied for the examination. If you do not receive this receipt, check "Junk", "Trash", or "Spam" folders for the primary email linked to your Online Application System (OASys) account. If you are unable to locate the email, you can view a summary of the notification email to you on your OASys Dashboard, then Notifications. If you are still unable to find the email, please email DCAS via the Contact feature available in OASys with a description of the issue and include the exam number and your profile number located on your Profile page. While on your Profile page, check that the email addresses you provided are correct and/or updated.

PENALTY FOR MISREPRESENTATION:

Any intentional misrepresentation on the application or examination may result in disqualification, even after promotion, and may result in criminal prosecution.
