General Statement of Duties and Responsibilities

Under direct supervision is responsible for the lubrication of power plant, pumping and/or construction equipment; performs related work.

Example of Typical Tasks

Lubricates and cleans pumps, engines, blowers, compressors, motors, gears, ejectors and other operating equipment.

Assists in the operation, maintenance and repair of this equipment.

Reads meters, gauges and other operating equipment.

Keeps logs.

Operates lubricant filtering and purifying equipment; maintains lubricant inventory.

May operate a motor vehicle in the performance of assigned duties.

Qualification Requirements

1. Three years of full-time satisfactory experience in the lubrication, maintenance and repair of mechanical equipment; or
2. One and one-half years of experience as described in "1" above plus graduation from an approved trade, technical or vocational high school or an approved internship program; or
3. One year of experience as described in "1" above plus an associate degree from an accredited school in mechanical technology.

License Requirement

For appointment to certain positions, possession of a Class B Commercial Driver License valid in the State of New York may be required. There may be certain age requirements to obtain this license. Employees must maintain the Class B Commercial Driver License during their employment.
