The Resident Engineer must insure that all critical regulatory signs are installed and maintained by the contractor during all phases of construction. These signs include Stop signs, Yield signs, One Way signs, and Do Not Enter signs.

These critical traffic signs, which control traffic flow through the intersection, must be adequately supported to withstand adverse weather conditions (i.e., ice, wind, and storm damage).

All existing regulatory signs designated to be removed and replaced with new or temporary signs shall remain in place until immediately prior to their replacement. No intersection shall remain unsigned for any period of time when vehicular traffic is allowed through the intersection. (ref: DDC Contract Specification, Supplementary Data, section 6.82B)
