

NOTICE OF PUBLIC HEARING

What is taking place? On February 1, 2022, Charter Communications/Spectrum applied for a variance from section 24-163 of the Administrative Code, which prohibits vehicle idling. A copy of this petition is posted on the DEP website in the “Transportation Emissions” section.

DEP has received at least one objection to the approval of the variance petition. When there is an objection to a variance petition, section 24-110 of the Administrative Code requires DEP to hold a public hearing.

- **By speaking at the hearing.** You can speak for up to five minutes at the hearing.

Note: The hearing will be recorded. You may request copies of any written comments or a copy of the hearing recording by making a request under the Freedom of Information Law (FOIL).
