NYC Homeless Outreach Population Estimate (HOPE) Survey


- Estimate of the number of people experiencing unsheltered homelessness and sleeping in public places such as streets, parks, and subways on a single winter night.
- Conducted annually since 2005; >2,500 volunteers deployed to:
 - All areas of the city where individuals experiencing homelessness are known to stay
 (i.e., "high density" areas) based on past surveys and outreach worker observations—all
 individuals experiencing homelessness in these areas are counted, and
 - Random sample of all other areas, termed "low density"—results from these areas used to <u>estimate</u> the number of individuals experiencing homelessness in areas not surveyed.
- Fulfills federal Department of Housing and Urban Development requirement for a January "point-in-time" survey of unsheltered individuals.



Key Findings

- Total estimate of 3,857 unsheltered individuals on streets and subways on the winter night of January 27th, 2020.
- Survey results estimate an underlying 23% decrease in unsheltered homelessness on the subways the night of January 27, 2020
- Taken together with the underlying estimated increase on the streets, the overall HOPE 2020 Survey results (3,857 in 2020) represents a 7% increase in unsheltered homelessness on the streets and subways over 2019 (3,588 in 2019).
- The decrease in unsheltered homelessness on the subways and the parallel increase on surface areas can be partially attributed to increased focus on subway outreach and initiatives, with outreach teams bringing New Yorkers to shelter placements from the subways as well as out from the subways to the streets where we can better engage them; as well as unseasonably warm weather.
