

CHAPTER 9
RAW SALT-CURED AIR-DRIED FISH

§9-01 Definitions.

Food and adulterated. When used in this regulation, the words "food" and "adulterated" shall have the meanings ascribed to them in §§71.03 and 73.03 of the New York City Health Code.

§9-02 Determination and Declaration.

Ready-to-eat raw, whole, unviscerated, salt-cured, air-dried fish, which may or may not be lightly smoked and is commonly sold under the names "kopchonka" "ribeyza" "rostov" and "rybetz" is hereby determined and declared to be "unfit for food" and, accordingly, is "adulterated" as that term is defined in §73.03(4) of the New York City Health Code.

§9-03 Prohibition.

It is hereby prohibited for any person to produce, pack, possess, sell, offer for sale, deliver or give away this fish product, pursuant to §71.05(a) of the Health Code.
