The New York City Department of Health and Mental Hygiene (NYC DOHMH) is seeking a qualified contractor to provide piloting services for aerial larviciding operation on an as needed City-wide basis, during the arboviral transmission season.

The contractor shall ensure that each aerial larval application are performed in a manner consistent with all applicable City, State and Federal Laws and regulations, during the active mosquito-breeding season or as determined by the DOHMH, generally June through September. In addition, the Contractor shall maintain all required regulatory and operational data in electronic format and provide to DOHMH all necessary records for each larvicide aerial application as required by all City, State and Federal regulations, and shall additionally provide reports in hard copy to DOHMH after each application.

The term of the proposed contract from the above-mentioned IFB will be June 1, 2012 through May 30, 2015 with an option to renew for two additional years after its termination date.
