Questions and Answers. One question was received regarding the Solicitation. DOHMH provides the following answer in response to the question.

Question 1: Can a Professional Engineer license supersede private certifications that are required (NEBB, AABC) according to the solicitation?

ANSWER 1: *Professional Engineer license does not supersede NEBB or AABC Certifications. All technicians performing actual Testing, Adjusting and Balancing (TAB) work shall be certified by AABC or NEBB and work directly under an AABC certified Test and Balance Engineer (TBE) or a NEBB certified Professional. Bidders must possess either one of these certifications.*
