

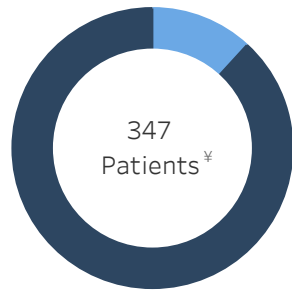

## Site-Specific Performance on Viral Load Suppression<sup>±</sup>

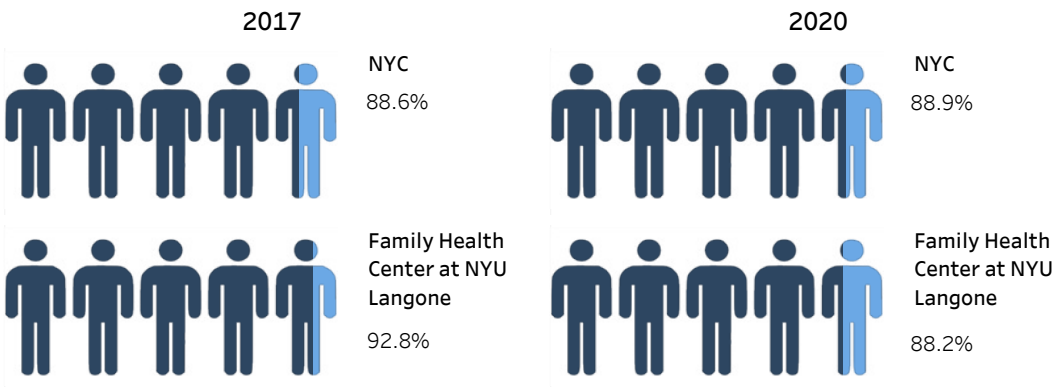

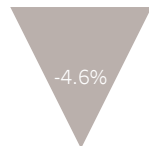


Suppressed : 306 (88.2%)
