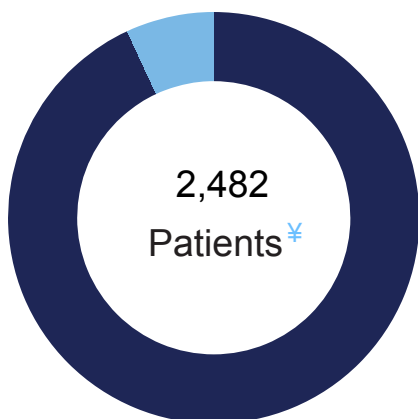

2015-2018 Progress on Viral Load Suppression



[¥]In Care: A person is considered to be established in HIV care if they had two CD4/VL tests at least 3 months apart in 2018

[±]Viral Load Suppression: Last quantitative HIV RNA value <200 copies/mL
