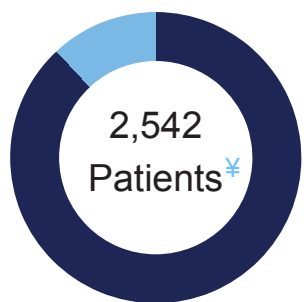

In 2017, Mount Sinai St. Luke's and Mount Sinai West Hospitals had 2,542 patients in care and achieved 88.1% on Viral Load Suppression. Mount Sinai St. Luke's and Mount Sinai West Hospitals are part of the Mount Sinai Health System. In 2017, the Mount Sinai Health System had 8,495 patients established in HIV care and achieved 91.0% on Viral Load Suppression, which represents an increase of 2.8% in Viral Load Suppression performance since 2014.
