

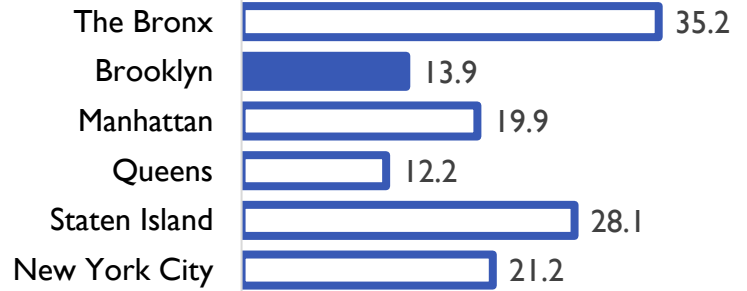
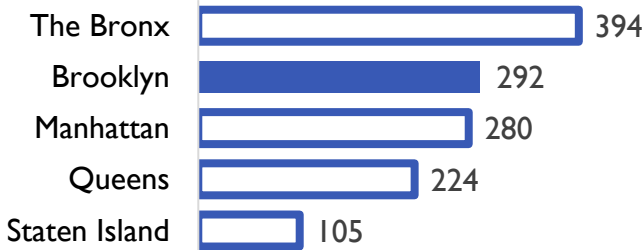
Overdose Deaths Among Brooklyn Residents, 2019

13.9 per 100,000 residents died of a drug overdose

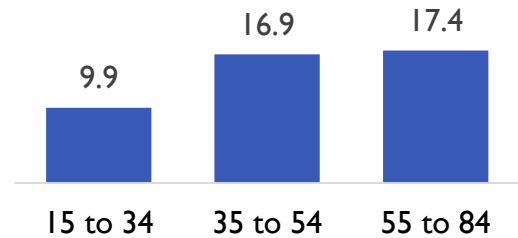
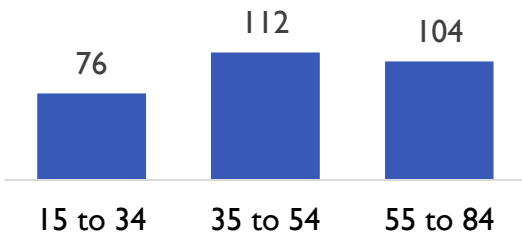
Brooklyn residents had the second largest number of overdose deaths.

Brooklyn residents had the second lowest rate of overdose death (per 100,000 residents).



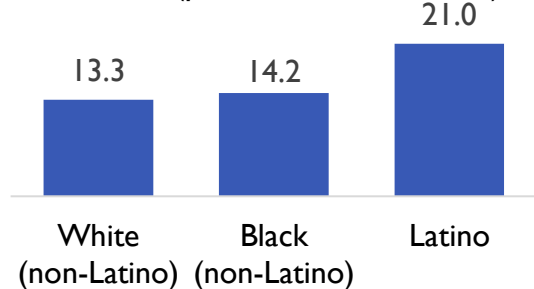
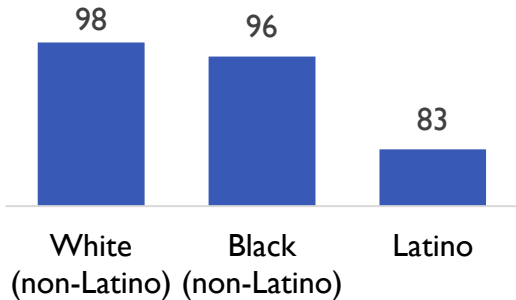
Brooklyn residents ages 35 to 54 had the largest number of overdose deaths.

Brooklyn residents ages 55 to 84 had the highest rate of overdose death (per 100,000 residents).

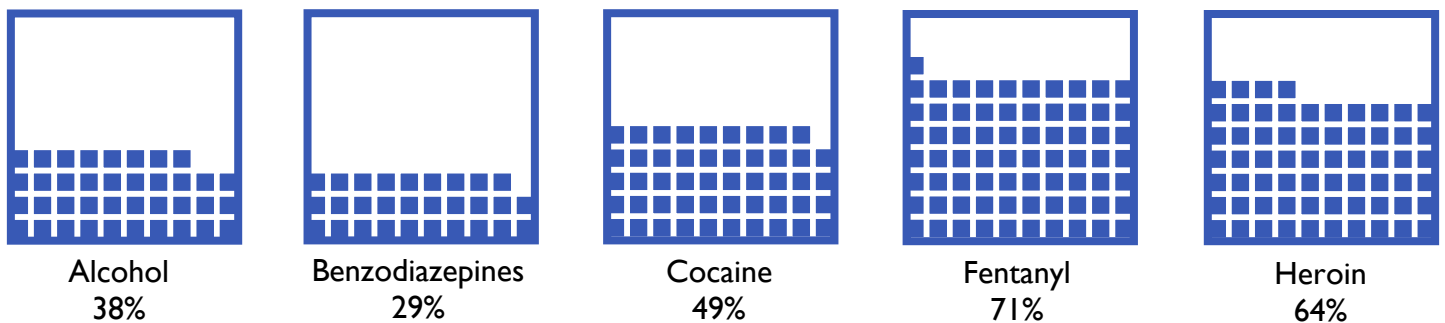


White Brooklyn residents had the largest number of overdose deaths.
