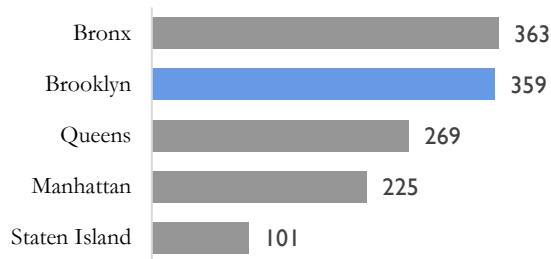


# Overdose deaths among Brooklyn residents, 2017

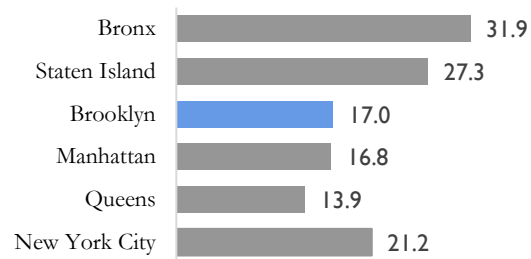
**359** Brooklyn residents died of a drug overdose

**17.0** per 100,000 residents died of a drug overdose

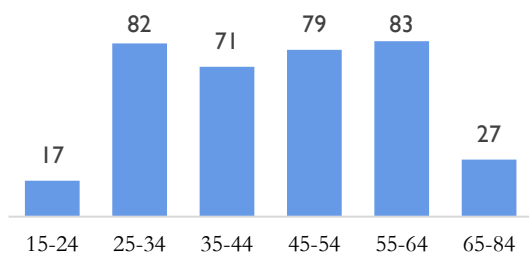
Brooklyn residents had the second highest number of overdose deaths



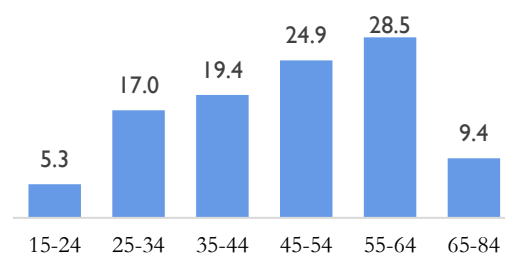
Brooklyn residents had the third highest rate of overdose deaths (per 100,000 residents)



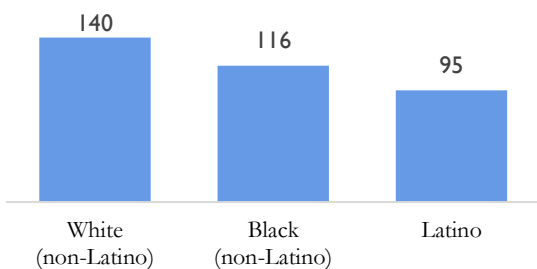
Fewest overdose deaths among Brooklyn residents aged 15-24



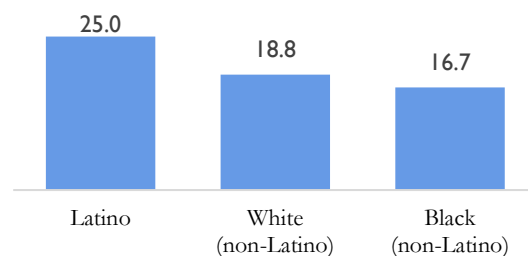
Brooklyn residents aged 55-64 had the highest rates of overdose deaths (per 100,000 residents)



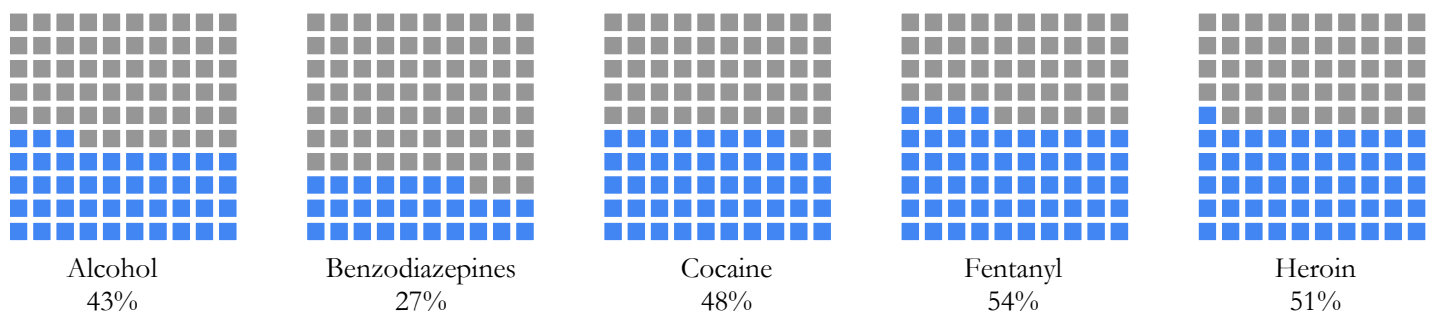
White Brooklyn residents had the largest number of overdose deaths
