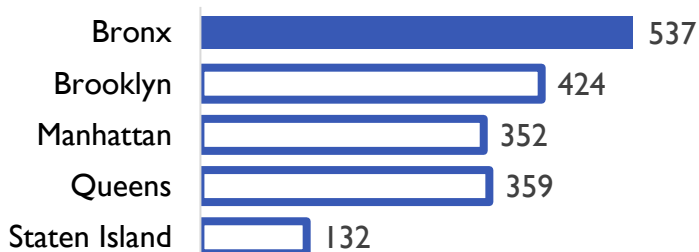


Overdose Deaths Among Bronx Residents, 2020

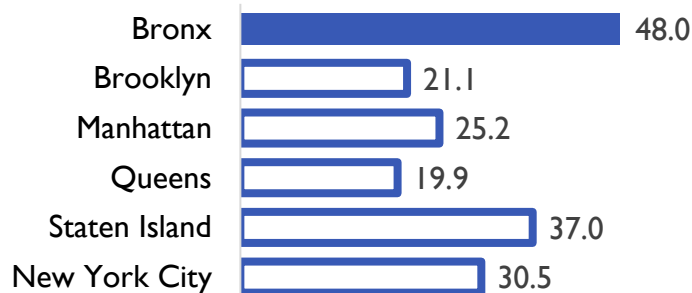
537 Bronx residents died of a drug overdose

48.0 per 100,000 residents died of a drug overdose

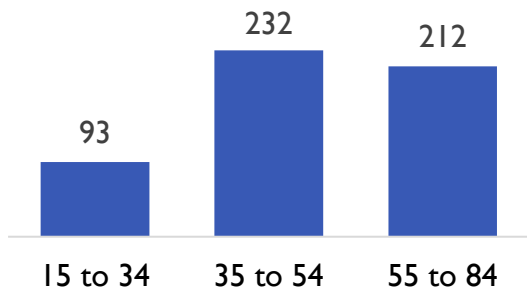
Bronx residents had the largest number of overdose deaths.



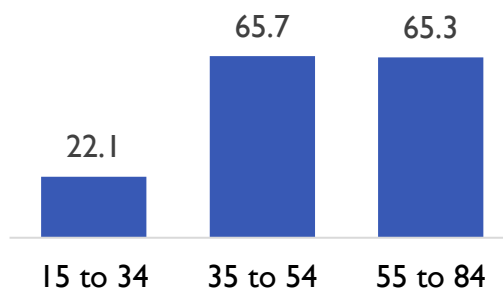
Bronx residents had the highest rate of overdose death (per 100,000 residents).



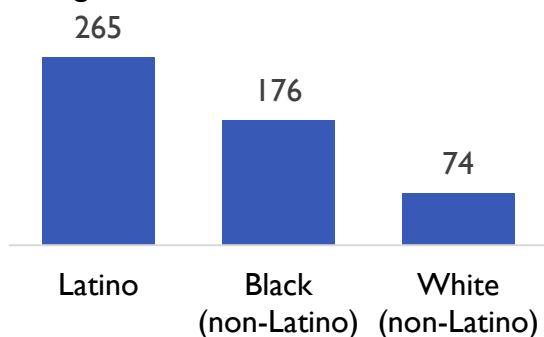
Bronx residents ages 35 to 54 had the largest number of overdose deaths.



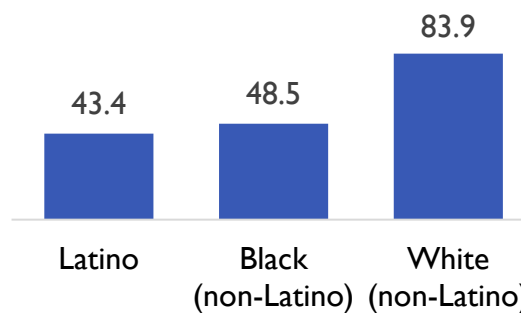
Bronx residents ages 35 to 54 had the highest rate of overdose death (per 100,000 residents).



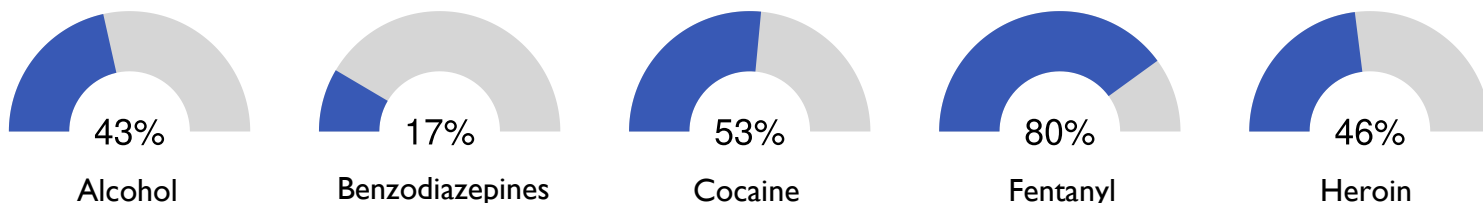
Latino Bronx residents had the largest number of overdose deaths.
