


Overdose Deaths Among Manhattan Residents, 2018


267 Manhattan residents died of a drug overdose

Manhattan residents had the third largest number of overdose deaths.




18.9 per 100,000 residents died of a drug overdose


Manhattan residents had the third highest rate of overdose death (per 100,000 residents).




Manhattan residents ages 35 to 54 had the largest number of overdose deaths.




Manhattan residents ages 15 to 34 had the lowest rate of overdose death (per 100,000 residents).




Latino Manhattan residents had the largest number of overdose deaths.
