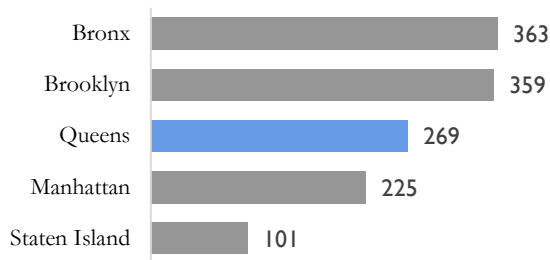


# Overdose deaths among Queens residents, 2017

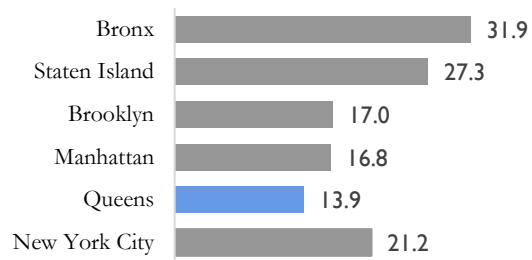
**269** Queens residents died of a drug overdose

**13.9** per 100,000 residents died of a drug overdose

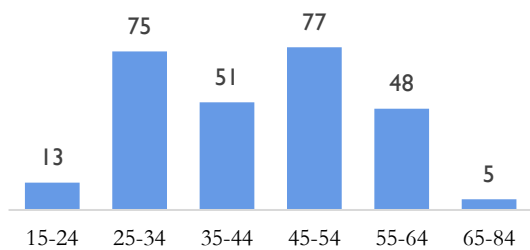
Queens residents had the third highest number of overdose deaths



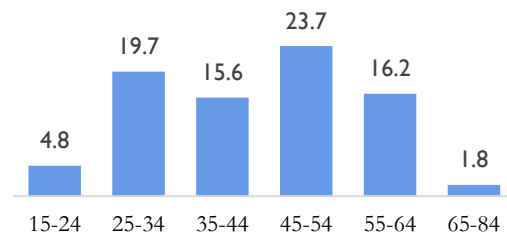
Queens residents had the lowest rate of overdose deaths (per 100,000 residents)



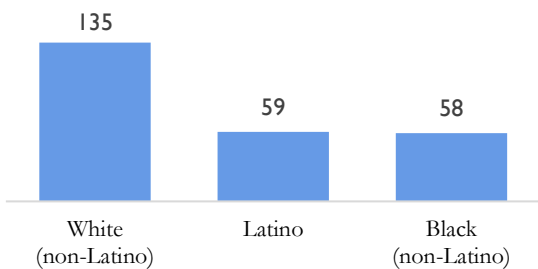
Queens residents aged 25-34 and 45-54 accounted for most deaths



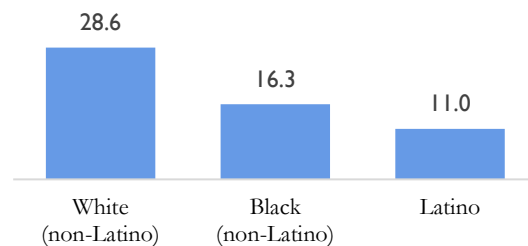
Queens residents aged 45-54 had the highest rates of overdose deaths (per 100,000 residents)



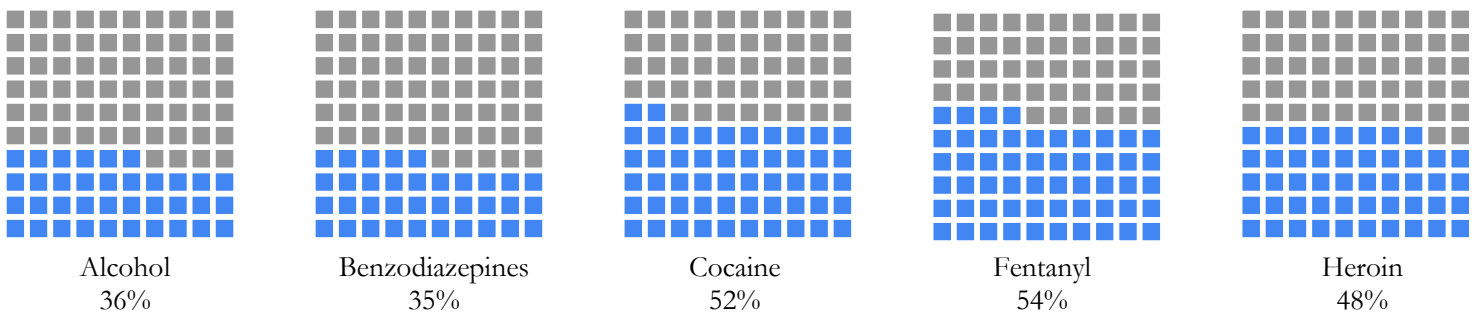
White Queens residents had the largest number of overdose deaths
