

# Overdose Deaths Among Staten Island Residents, 2020

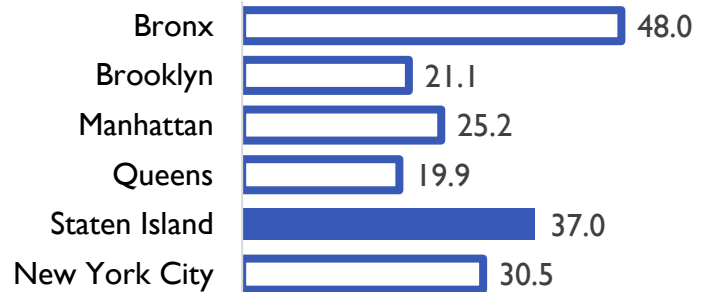
**132** Staten Island residents died of a drug overdose

**37.0** per 100,000 residents died of a drug overdose

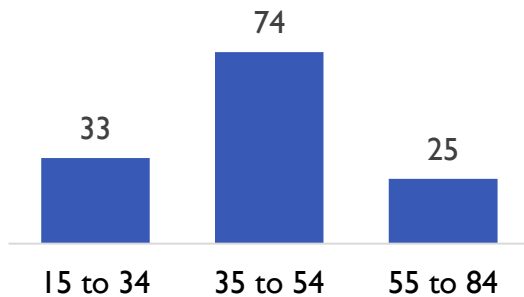
Staten Island residents had the smallest number of overdose deaths.



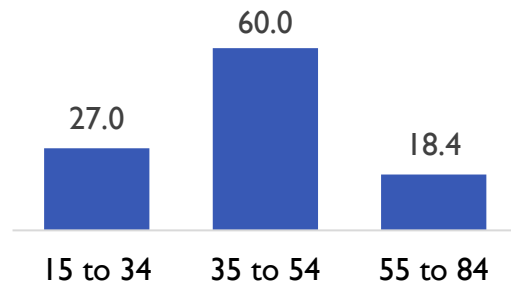
Staten Island residents had the second highest rate of overdose death (per 100,000 residents).



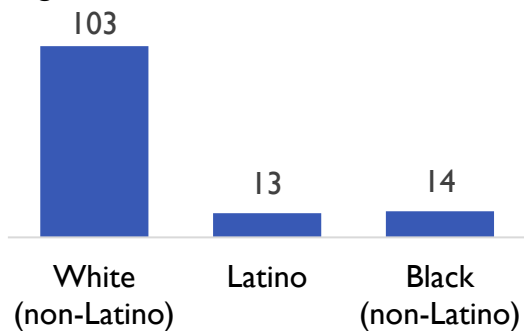
Staten Island residents ages 35 to 54 had the largest number of overdose deaths.



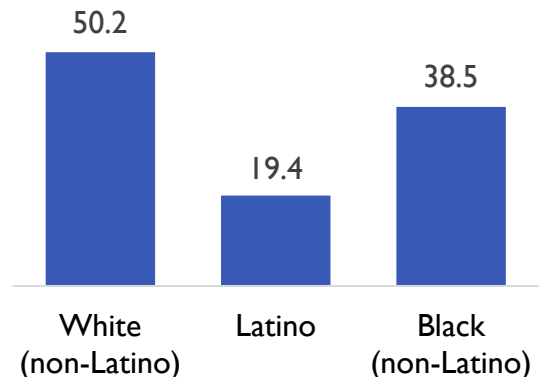
Staten Island residents ages 35 to 54 had the highest rate of overdose death (per 100,000 residents).



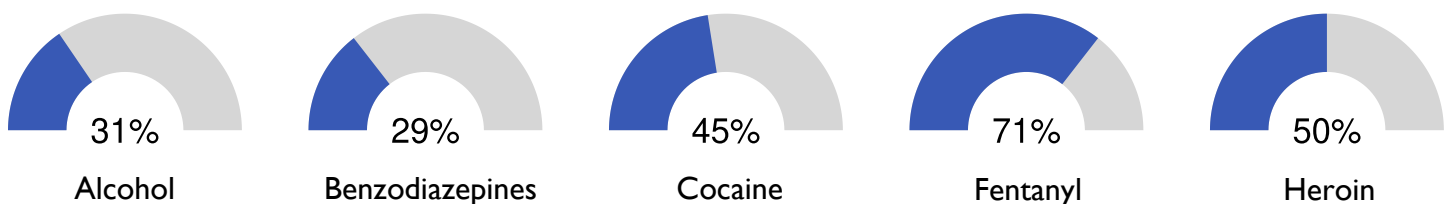
White Staten Island residents had the largest number of overdose deaths.
