Readiness Status	The CIR’s HL7 Web service is currently ready to accept data and is capable of supporting bidirectional, real-time interfaces with EHR systems, conforming with the CDC HL7 2.5.1 Implementation Guide for Immunization Messaging, Release 1.3 . By 01/01/2017, the CIR will also conform to the CDC HL7 2.5.1 Implementation Guide for Immunization Messaging, Release 1.5 and addendum , including supporting Query/Response and National Drug Codes for newly-administered immunizations.
