



New Inspection Procedures to Protect You and Health Department Staff From COVID-19

To protect you, Health Department inspectors:

- Wear a face covering. Inspectors may also wear goggles, face shields or other personal protective equipment, depending on the situation.
- Stay at least 6 feet away from other people as much as possible.
- Wash their hands or use an alcohol-based hand sanitizer before and after conducting an inspection.
- Monitor themselves for symptoms and stay home if sick.

To protect Health Department inspectors and your coworkers, you should:

- Wear a face covering. Even if you have no symptoms, you can still have COVID-19 and spread it to others. Face coverings protect other people.
- Keep at least 6 feet away from the inspector and other people as much as possible.
- Practice good hand hygiene, including washing your hands often with soap and water for at least 20 seconds (or using an alcohol-based hand sanitizer if soap and water are not available).
- Stay home if you are sick.
